

## 1. BASIS

The contents and activities in this unit focus on the history of Spain in the Middle Ages. We will start with the Visigothic Kingdom, we will then study Islamic Spain and the creation of al-Andalus. We will see the construction of the Christian kingdoms and the *Reconquista*. We will focus on how medieval society was organised and the coexistence of the three religions. We will also analyse medieval artistic forms and the Way of St. James.

## 2. METHODOLOGY

In this unit, the pupils will gain a better understanding of the Middle Ages, Islamic Spain and al-Andalus, how the Christian kingdoms were created and the *Reconquista*. They will analyse the organisation of medieval society and will learn about the coexistence of the three main religions. They will also learn about medieval artistic movements and will analyse the Way of St. James.
